TITLE: Crisis Management Plan

POLICY NUMBER: GO19.3

Rationale:

Emergency preparedness is essential for the maximum protection of students and staff. Instruction in emergency preparedness provides students and staff members with the knowledge and understanding to meet both the natural and man-made hazards that may occur.

Policy Statement:

The Virginia School for the Deaf and the Blind (VSDB) provides written Crisis Management procedures for implementation during emergency situations and training to personnel to ensure the safety and welfare of students and staff. An electronic copy is available on the school Web Site.

Procedure:

The Director of Public Safety shall update the VSDB Crisis Management Plan annually and provide written copies to all areas of the campus. Crisis Management training is included in the required annual on-line employee training.
